The Department of Health and Senior Services is pleased to announce that the income limit for the AIDS Drug Distribution Program (ADDP) has been increased to 500 percent of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL).

Individuals between 300 and 500 percent of the FPL who previously qualified for the Temporary AIDS Supplemental Rebate and Federal Assistance Program (TASRFAP), became eligible for the AADDP program on July 15, 2011. The TASRFAP program is no longer necessary.

The chart below explains the new AADDP income limits.

AADDP INCOME LIMITS EFFECTIVE July 15, 2011	
Persons in Family	Income Limits
1	\$54,450
2	\$73,550
3	\$92,650
4	\$111,750
5	\$130,850

For families with more than 5, add \$19,100 for each additional person.
