- All items have been reviewed and approved by an external review panel made up of representatives from the HIV prevention and service community.
- New Jersey residents and community-based organizations may order limited quantities of the materials listed in this catalog, free of charge, as long as funds exist to provide this service.

How to Order HIV/AIDS Printed Materials

Step 2 Complete the electronic order form found at <http://nj.gov/health/aids/publications/orderform.shtml>

Should you not have access to the Internet,

Step 1 Locate the **HIV/AIDS Printed Materials Order Form** on the last page of the **Consumer Catalog of HIV/AIDS Materials** referenced above.

Step 2 Clearly type or print the information requested in the information block of each **HIV/AIDS Printed Materials Order Form**. Make sure that the address used is the address to which the materials are to be mailed. Do not use a Post Office Box as the mailing address. Make sure that you limit your order to 500 items.

Step 3 Fax or mail, completed **HIV/AIDS Printed Materials Order Forms** to the Division of HIV/AIDS Services (DHAS). 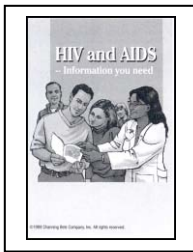


New Jersey AIDS Resource Guide

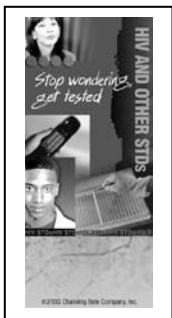
MATERIALS ON HIV TESTING AND GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT HIV



HIV and AIDS Information You Need to Know (NJH013/NJH013S)

Realistic style, color booklet in English or Spanish, published by the Channing Bete Company, Inc. (6 x 8 inches)

This booklet provides basic information about the immune system and HIV transmission, along with basic tips for reducing the risk for HIV infection related to sex, perinatal transmission, injecting drug use. Also included is information about HIV testing, medical treatment, and relevant hotline telephone numbers.



HIV And Other STDs—Stop Wondering Get Tested (NJH009/NJH009S)

Eight-panel, 3 ½ x 8" folder, full-color, published by the Channing Bete Company as part of their Eliminating Disparities series, medium literacy, available in English only

Specifically designed for young adults and sexually active older teens, this booklet encourages HIV testing for individuals who think they might have put themselves at risk of infection. It explains where to go for testing and describes the kinds of behaviors that place people at risk for HIV and other STDs.



HIV Testing—Get the Facts (NJH056/NJH056S)

Eight-panel, 3 ½ x 8" folder, full-color, published by the Channing Bete Company as part of their Eliminating Disparities series, medium literacy, available in English only

A clear, simple message about the importance of getting tested is presented in this pamphlet which provides a more generic presentation of the facts about who should get tested, how HIV tests work, what results mean, where to get tested, and how to proceed after getting either a positive or negative result.



Rapid HIV Testing—Why wait to find out? (NJH062/NJH062S)

Eight-panel 3 1/2 x 3”, full-color, low-literacy, photo illustrated folder published by the Channing Bete) Company, available in English and Spanish

Readers at frequent risk for HIV are encouraged to include the OraQuick rapid HIV test as a routine part of their health care. This pamphlet emphasizes that the rapid HIV test is quick, providing results in less than an hour. Also provides information about the meaning of test results, basic information about HIV, and who may be at risk for HIV infection.

MATERIALS FOR WOMEN



A Healthy Pregnancy and HIV Testing (NJ050/NJH050S)

Eight-panel, 3 1/2 x 8” folder, full-color photo graphics, low literacy, published by the Channing Bete Company

Designed to address perinatal HIV transmission, this pamphlet urges women to take steps to protect their baby as well as themselves from HIV infection, and promotes HIV testing, explaining how HIV medications taken under medical supervision may improve chances for having a healthy baby.



Protect Yourself from HIV – For Women (NJ060/NJH060S)

Eight-panel, 3 1/2 x 8” folder, full-color photo graphics, low literacy, published by the Channing Bete Company, available in English only

This pamphlet is part of the Channing Bete Company’s Eliminating Disparities Series for addressing HIV infection among African American populations. It also provides realistic “Sister to Sister” scenarios and basic information about HIV for African American women ages 25-34, emphasizing consistent and correct condom use, and HIV testing for sexually active women, and contact information for additional resources.

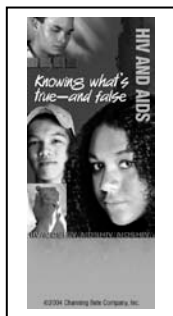


Sisters Talk About HIV—Alma’s Story (NJ064/NJH064S)

Along with HIV basics, this booklet provides advice to help empower women to protect themselves from HIV. Encourages honest communication, consistent condom use, and HIV testing, along with information about other HIV-related resources.

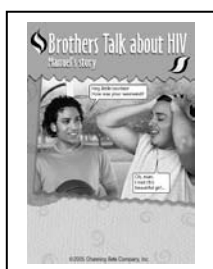
MATERIALS FOR MEN

It provides basic information about HIV for sexually active men committed to doing the right thing, and emphasizes consistent and correct condom use, HIV testing, and contact information for additional resources.

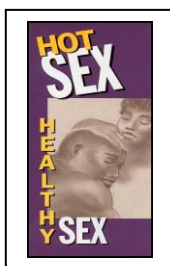


Brothers Talk about HIV—Manuel’s Story (NJ004/NJH004S)

It focuses on behaviors that place people at risk for HIV and encourages HIV rapid testing, while providing information on other HIV-related resources.

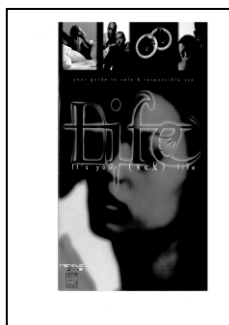
MATERIALS ON SAFER SEX



Hot Sex Healthy Sex (NJH048)

Six-panel 3 ½ x 8 “ realistic style pamphlet, in English, published by the American Social Health Association, low literacy, available in English only

Intended for sexually active adults, this pamphlet provides concise information about correct and consistent condom use for the reduction of risk for HIV and other sexually transmitted infections. It also provides a step-by-step guidance for correct condom use, along with a listing of national HIV and STD hotlines.



It’s Your (Sex) Life: Your Guide to Safe and Responsible Sex (NJH100)

32-page full-color informational 8.5 x 11 “booklet published by the Henry J. Kaiser Family Foundation and the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services, medium to high literacy

This booklet provides sexually active readers with practical information about safer sex, sexually transmitted diseases, contraception, and pregnancy prevention; and discusses the dangers of mixing drugs and alcohol with sex, safer sex, and tips of talking to one’s partner about safer sex.

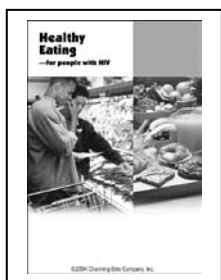
MATERIALS FOR PEOPLE LIVING WITH HIV

Eight-page folder, 3 ½ x 8", full-color, photo illustrated, medium literacy, published by the Channing Bete Company, available in English and Spanish

As part of the Channing Bete Company's HIV: Positive Choices series, this pamphlet encourages people living with HIV to take charge of their lives, providing advice for following their treatment plan. Readers are advised to take all medications as prescribed, and to make lifestyle choices that help them stay on track. This pamphlet advocates developing a support system and lists sources for additional information.



Healthy Eating – For People with HIV (NJ054/NJH054S)

Fifteen-page booklet, 5 ½ x 8", photo illustrated, medium literacy, available in English and Spanish

This booklet explains how eating well can help people living with HIV stay healthy, manage side effects from medications, and fight infections. It addresses many nutritional concerns of people with HIV, and the basics of a well-balanced diet, while providing guidance on how to combat specific symptoms and medication side effects through dietary changes.

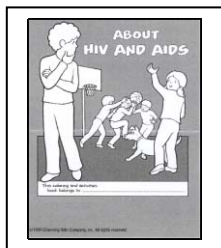


When It's Time to Tell—Disclosing HIV+ Status (NJH019/NJH019S)

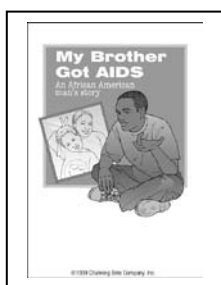
MATERIALS FOR YOUTH AND ADOLESCENTS

My Brother Got AIDS (NJH020)

Eight-page realistic style booklet, 5 ½ x 8 inches, developed by the Channing Bete Company, low literacy, available in English only

This booklet was developed for African American youth and focuses on the impact of HIV/AIDS on communities of color. Along with basic information about HIV transmission, prevention, and risk reduction, it addresses the excuses that people give for not practicing safer sex, and discusses along with guidelines for using condoms correctly and consistently.



HIV And AIDS—Knowing What's True and False (NJH008)

Eight-page folder, 3 ½ x 8", full-color, photo illustrated, medium literacy, published by the Channing Bete Company

Mature teens and young adults get the facts they need for a clear, basic understanding of HIV and AIDS and how to protect themselves and others from infection. This pamphlet, which features bold graphics and youth-focused text, promote HIV testing for sexually-active readers.
